### The First Sunday of Advent - December 2, 2018

Today marks the first weekend of Advent. The word "Advent" stems from the Latin word "adventus" which literally means "coming" or "arrival." In context, this commonly refers to the coming of Jesus on Christmas Day.

During Advent, our Catholic tradition invites us to display an advent wreath in our homes and to use it as a form of prayer by lighting the candles each day according to which week we are in. You may use the following prayers during Advent:

#### <u>Week #1</u> – light one purple candle

Stir up your might, we beg you, O Lord, and come, so that we may escape through your protection and be saved by your help from the dangers that threaten us because of our sins. We ask this of you who reigns for ever and ever. Amen.

#### Week #2 – light two purple candles

O Lord, stir up our hearts that we may prepare for your only begotten Son, that through His coming we may be made worthy to serve you with pure souls. We ask this through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.

#### Week #3 – light two purple and one pink candle

We humbly beg you, O Lord, to listen to our prayers, and by the grace of your coming, bring light into our darkened minds. We ask this of you who reigns for ever and ever. Amen.

#### Week #4 – light all four candles

Stir up your might, we pray O Lord, and come; rescue us through your great strength so that salvation, which has been hindered by our sins, may be hastened by the grace of your gentle mercy. We ask this of you who lives and reigns for ever and ever. Amen.

Wishing you a blessed Advent season as you prepare your hearts and minds for the baby Jesus that you will find on Christmas Day!


