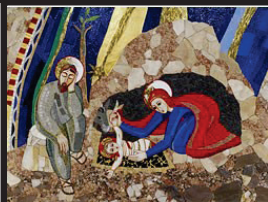


What's Happening at Erie Shores South Catholic Family of Parishes?

The Loud Silence of St. Joseph
Saint Joseph, while he never spoke a word in scripture, is one of the most beloved saints. His silent example of obedient faithfulness is a most needed

example in our age of noise and confusion.

St. Joseph's silent trust in Divine Providence is a witness that rings louder than any words.

St. Joseph communicated Love. He was charged with the supreme honour of educating, instructing and guiding Jesus .

The Mother of God and the Incarnate Word Himself honoured St. Joseph's authority by their silence as being head of the Holy Family, to whom perfect obedience was due.

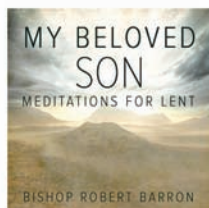
