From Fr. Tom...

Since the time I have been here I have realized just how many dedicated and generous parishioners we have. So many people work hard to make our parish vibrant and alive.

I want to acknowledge Veronica, who behind the scenes is often involved in many of the events of St. Michael's. She has been a tremendous resource for Fr. Steve and I as we have gotten to know the parish and the dynamics of parish life! I've relied on her a lot and I've realized her role involves a lot more than youth – assisting with the liturgical life of the parish, helping with coordination and scheduling, and being connected to many families in our community.

I think it's important her title reflect that, so starting right away, Veronica will be known as our Pastoral Minister here at St. Michael's. This change in title will allow her to be able to offer guidance and advice in many facets of parish life and allow her to participate in any ongoing diocesan training of Pastoral Ministers.

As part of this new role, I've asked to her to oversee all of the sacramental preparation here in our parish. In addition to Confirmation, she will also oversee the Baptism preparation program, First Reconciliation program and the First Communion program. Veronica has started to incorporate family ministry in many of her activities, and I know family ministry is an important dimension of our sacramental preparation, so this will allow her to specialize in working with the families of our parish who have children getting ready for the sacraments.

Although she will still lead Vacation Bible School and be a liaison to our schools, I know these new responsibilities will not allow for enough time to maintain our youth groups or youth events, so I hope to explore other ways of youth ministry in the next few months.

We definitely believe this is an exciting time in the life of our parish and I am eager to see what the Lord has prepared for us.


