February 3, 2019 - Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

This weekend's readings speak a lot about love. The first reading speaks about how God loved us so much that when he formed us in the womb, he consecrated us. He has dedicated us to a higher purpose and promises to always be with us. Do you ever doubt that God has created you with a special purpose in mind? How will God use you to build up His church?

The second reading continues with this theme saying that love is patient and kind. When was the last time you showed love to a child who couldn't sit still or to a parent who wasn't able to move as quickly due to age and ailments?

In today's Gospel, we hear about Mary and Joseph bringing the baby Jesus to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord. Simeon's words hurt Mary, but she knew that she needed to give her Son to the world. When was the last time you gave something without begrudging it? Are you willing to give of yourself in order to make the world a better place?

As a Youth Minister I often find myself looking at ways I can love the person in front of me. To be honest, there are some days that I am not very good at it and I feel like a failure for not treating someone with the love that they should be shown. In my humanness, I forget I am God's vessel showing the path to Jesus. Jesus' words encourage us to know that even in our failures we are able to begin again and continue to show others what it means to love.

In February we will be offering a **Keep Connected Program** for parents and their 10-14 year old children. This is a wonderful opportunity for parents and children to show each other **how to love**. This six week program begins with a meal followed by activities and a discussion each week. **We begin on February 21** and topics range from showing respect to one another and supporting each other. 
