On Friday January 6th we will begin to provide ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT in St. Peter's Chapel which will begin immediately after the Divine Mercy Devotions, and continue through the night until 7:00am Saturday mornings. This will be available for anyone coming through the night to pray for all of our vocations, especially for new vocations to the Priesthood and service in the Church. Every parish in our Deanery takes an all-night commitment to Adoration, and ours will be EVERY FRIDAY. Bishop LaRocque oversees this effort, so that somewhere in our Deanery, perpetual adoration is available. In order to assure that someone is present, we would invite you to consider signing for the time you can come—if we have 2 or 3 for each hour, all the better. It is important that we do not leave the Blessed Sacrament exposed without someone present in prayer.

The Knights of Columbus are helpful with this prayer project, as their apostolate includes prayer for their families and the vocations of their sons. It is customary in some Councils of the K of C for fathers to bring their sons for a time of prayer together. The Catholic Women's League is also apostolically oriented to the protection and growth of family life, and this would be a wonderful way to grow our awareness of the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. All young people and members of the Youth Commission are encouraged to take advantage of this opportunity to spend time in Our Lord's presence in the Blessed Sacrament.

All parishioners are invited to this unique prayer experience. I am hoping that someone from our Vocations Committee can join in the deanery meetings with Bishop LaRocque to promote awareness of this wonderful privilege and gift we have in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament.


