From Fr. Tom: JANUARY 12, 2020 - BAPTISM OF THE LORD

Happy New Year and Thank You! Thank you to everyone over the past month who helped to make the Advent and Christmas Season so beautiful. This thank you is to everyone who dedicated their time and energy to making our liturgies so beautiful. I am grateful to our parish staff and to everyone who sang, decorated, served, assisted at Mass and coordinated all the schedules.

I also want to thank all those who gave of themselves to reach out to those who struggle during this holiday season financially or emotionally. The generosity of our parishioners and the St. Vincent de Paul Society is remarkable. Over the past year, the Saint Vincent de Paul Society served hundreds of bags of groceries to our friends and neighbours here in Leamington. In addition to that, we also courageously worked toward social change through our Life Chain and the work of the Right to Life committee. Thank you also to all who have assisted in welcoming the Byamungu family and making them feel a part of our community.

Our past year has been full of activity: we celebrated 68 Baptisms, 20 Weddings, 80 Funerals, 46 First Communions and 74 Confirmations! We met in small groups for ongoing formation, to study the bible, to prepare for Christmas through our parish mission and share faith. Many people consecrated themselves to Mary on her feast day. We have begun a prayer shawl ministry to connect parishioners as interceders for the needs of our families and communities.

We finished our renovations from the St. Michael's office and the link. We reduced our debt by \$734,697.30. Our pastoral council is currently working toward discerning pastoral priorities for our lives of love and service here at St Michael's. We are excited to begin the process of being a Family of Parishes with Kingsville and Pelee Island.

We celebrated moving, faith filled festivals, including the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the St. Michael's festival. We restarted our RCIA, welcoming 7 adults into the faith at Easter. This year we were blessed to add a 6:00pm Mass, followed by our *Edge* youth group, and last week we welcomed 100 people to be a part of the Alpha series.

None of this includes the activity of the Catholic Women's League and the Knights of Columbus here in our parish...their prayers, memorial Masses, breakfasts, charitable donations, fundraising and fellowship enhances the spiritual life of all their members and all of us by extension.

We continued to focus on family ministry, engaging young people and families and having strong relationships with the great teachers and staff in our schools.

This weekend we mark the feast of the Baptism of the Lord and we remember to thank God for the gift of our faith and the many opportunities the Lord gives us to live it out and share our faith with others. This weekend let us ask the blessing of God that this upcoming year will be full of blessings; much like our past year!
