#### The Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time - July 1, 2018

My ministry with young people has given me joy that I did not think would ever be possible. There have been key moments in my life where I have had a sense that God was calling me to more than just surviving each day. My parents played a great role in instilling the faith and challenging me when I didn't feel that going to church was something that I cared to do anymore, especially when many of my friends were not living the faith.

Through time that all changed. I became more involved with church as a volunteer. The more I volunteered the more I thirsted for knowledge. Growing up as a cradle Catholic I think I took advantage of my faith. It took a near tragedy to hear God say to me that I needed to go back to school and to learn more about church teaching and theology. Answering that call has made all the difference in the world. Although there are moments that I feel unworthy and question why God has called me to this ministry, God always finds a way of revealing Himself in the chaos and turmoil. I certainly had that experience this week.

The last few weeks I've been preparing for our Vacation Bible School program. The theme revolves around young people discerning their vocation. My desire is to have young people know that no matter what God calls you to do, it's important to keep our eyes focused on Jesus and to follow Him. If they do that, everything else will fall into place.

This week I had 25 teenagers show up wanting to help and serve. Young people want to be involved and want to be part of something bigger and they need us standing beside them helping them along even if we don't know all the answers. Loving them and being present is the best thing we can do.

I am currently looking for some adults to help with our VBS program this year. It is my hope that when it is time for me to retire, one of these young people that have participated in our programs will want to take my place because an adult was willing to walk with them.

In the next couple of weeks I will be placing a donation list in the bulletin of items currently needed for VBS. Your donations can be another way to give back to the church and to our young people.

I ask you to continue to pray for our young people and to look for ways to help your church. Trust me, once you make the decision to go deeper and become involved your faith will grow tremendously.


