#### Fifteenth/Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

\* The prophets continue in our day to call God's people to return to God. If we ignore them, we become a people that are like 'sheep without a shepherd', wandering about in great confusion and prey to every dangerous predator, until Jesus becomes the Good Shepherd and gathers us in the one flock that is His, the Church. There, he continues to guide us by the gentle breath of the Holy Spirit, and empowers us to continue his prophetic ministry by introducing him to everyone in our little worlds so they feel safe in his embrace.

In C.S. Lewis, Mere Christianity, we find 'food for thought' and prayer: "The real problem of the Christian life comes where people do not usually look of it. It comes the very moment you wake up in the morning. All your wishes and hopes for the day rush at you like wild animals. And the first job each morning consists simply in driving them all back, in listening to that other voice, taking the other point of view, letting that other larger, stronger, quieter life come flowing in ....coming in out of the wind."


