The World Cup of Baked Beans will be awarded during our picnic this Sunday.

We will begin with the celebration of Mass at 3:00 p.m. This Sunday's Gospel calls us to hospitality and a listening heart as Jesus converses with his friends, Martha and Mary.

REMEMBER: THERE WILL BE NO SUNDAY EVE- NING MASS THIS WEEK

A little update: A lot of progress happened this week. While the contractor was working on the new parking lot, tradesmen were working to complete the dry-walling and some of the finishing touches to lighting and design on the inside of the new St. Michael's. What is amazing is that our outdoor statue of St. Michael continues to stand guard over the whole project! The interior designer, Achim Klass, came to make plans for the refurbishing of our tabernacles that will be joined together and face both the church and the chapel. He also inspected the special wall behind the main Altar where our new crucifix will unify our attention as a Catholic community at prayer in the Eucharistic Sacrifice. (Last week, a little child was looking at the figure of Jesus that is mounted at St. Joseph's, and asked out loud during Mass if it was a real man, so lifelike this work of art is.) Consultation with the marble craftsmen continued to plan for the transport of our Altar and for the mounting of the mosaics of the archangels, Michael and Gabriel. The 'dove' which symbolizes the Holy Spirit will be featured on several items: over the main entrance, over the tabernacle and on the Ambo where the Word of God will be proclaimed. Work continued on preparing the six shrine area that will house the statues of Our Lady of Guadalupe, Our Lady of Fatima, Santo Cristo, St. Michael, St. Joseph, and Ste.-Anne. The Bose people came to retrieve our sound-system 'mixer' and to complete detailed plans for the use of screens and the plug-in devices for instruments in the choir area.

While all this is happening, the Parish Advisory Council and Pastoral Team reflected on the interior/spiritual life of our parish which is a community of faith called to be on the mission of Jesus, to bring people together in the Faith. Consultations with the musical leadership of our liturgies took place, and with the Altar Servers. We need to consider deeply how we continued...

We are truly blessed to have two missionaries from Guatemala who are capable in English, French, Italian and Portuguese. Father Eduardo will be following Father Chris' ministry in the parish as a whole, and Father Hugo Santa Cruz will soon join us to give pastoral care to the migrants of Hispanic cultures. Our new church will accommodate more people than the old St. Michael's or St. Joseph's, and so a change in the liturgical schedule of Mass on Sunday mornings will be made for the good of all. The festivals of Faith after Easter will continue in our new circumstances, and the availability of weekly Mass will gather people at Our Lady of Blessed Sacrament in Wheatley. We will need to discover ways to give priestly and pastoral service to Kingsville, in the very near future.
