

Gleaners Update

The SWO Gleaners has continued to operate through the last provincial lockdown. As an essential service, we remained open as most of our volunteers have been vaccinated and safety measures continued to be in place. One large measure we took, to ensure social distancing, was splitting the morning up into two shifts of 12 maximum volunteers. This reduced the amount of volunteers by over half but we have done as well as expected with production. Currently, as restrictions begin to ease, we are slowly getting more volunteers back. We continue to process all kinds of produce, and package a healthy veggie mix for distribution locally and internationally. Due to COVID-19, we have had to cancel our Annual Spring Fundraiser again in 2021. We hope that we can get back to having this event next spring, as it's a very important fundraiser for us and is an enjoyable evening for our supporters. Through sponsorships, ticket sales and auction items, this event has raised over \$90,000 for our operations each year. Not having this event has left an impact on our income for 2021, and the SWO Gleaners like many charities and businesses are feeling the financial pinch.

We are grateful for temporary government programs and grants that have assisted us over the past two years. This has helped take the pressure off, but does not cover all of our expenses. Generous donations are what fund us, and the more money we take in, the more food we can distribute to those in need. If you are able, please consider making a financial donation to the SWO Gleaners.
