We hosted Matteo Bocelli, son of Andrea Bocelli at an evening event at our home. With a lot of work and effort from Lorraine Sabga, Lina lacobelli, Priscilla lacobelli, Tania lacobelli and Sandy Mastronardi and after many emails and phone calls, Lorraine finally was able to form an agreement with Matteo Bocelli's agent.

Matteo's visit was to be a very beautiful outdoor concert event. Matteo arrived in Leamington on the evening of June 14. This brought a lot of details and work to complete; however, our team was quickly ready and got to work!

Also, Diana Remark and Sandra Macera prepared beautiful gifts for all who attended the event. We had invited 65 couples, 15 Priests and both Bishops. All food, beverages and services were all provided to the guests courtesy of Lina and Henry, with no cost incurred by the church. All invited couples donated directly to the St. Michael's Building Fund (a minimum of \$6000/couple was suggested). There were many who generously donated much more. There were also guests who donated yet were unable to attend. Some of those who donated were not even Catholic!

We raised \$707,000.00

The cost for Matteo and crew came to \$130,000.00 Set up costs were \$14,000.00

The total amount for St Michael's was \$563,000.00 Matteo Bocelli's performance and presence was a big hit as he remained after the concert to mingle and visit with everyone, which added to the flair of the evening. Thank you to everyone who helped. Thank you to all who came and generously donated. Now that the Church construction is complete our Parish Building Committee has completed its task.


