The third point is that some of you are more disturbed that I just said *damn* than you are about the millions who are starving and homeless." Then the pastor sat down to let the people think about what he had just said.

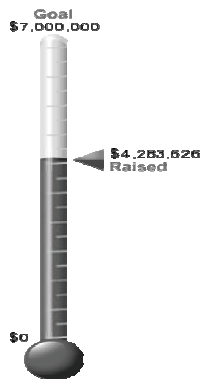
