What is it that Deacons do?

Our training takes 5 years; the first year is spent inquiring about the process and the possibility of entering into formal formation. During this time, the seminary obtains personal information about us and we obtain information about the roles and duties of a Deacon. The next 4 years are spent, one weekend a month, at the seminary in London learning everything from Theological Foundations, Foundations for Ministry, Sacramental and Liturgical Ministries as well as learning the Church (Canon) Law. We also learn how to be comfortable speaking in front of people and preparing proper Homilies so as to open up the Word of God for you. Between our times at the seminary, we gather as a smaller group, usually 3-4 diaconal couples, twice a month. We review what was learned at the Seminary and prepare for the coming weekend discussing the new reading material given to us. All of this prepared us for our Ordination as Permanent Deacons in the Diocese of London. Our ordination day was an extremely grace filled day, not only for us, but also for the communities we would now be serving. Bishop Fabbro appointed us to a Parish under which we would serve the 3 munera, or duties of our ordination. Our Ministry of Word allows us to proclaim the Gospel at Mass and we can also be asked to preach occasionally at Mass or other liturgies. During our Ministry of Sacrament we prepare the altar, we minister Holy Communion, we baptize children and witness wedding vows outside of Mass. We also preside at funeral vigils and services or interments for your loved ones. The largest component of our service to the Church is our Ministry of Charity in which we serve the poorest of the poor. It is here that we come as Christ did, to serve. Our outreach on behalf of the Church is the most fulfilling time as we bring our Church to those who may not be able to experience it as fully as you do. This can include nursing homes, hospitals, prison ministry, food kitchens, hospices, shut-ins, bereavement groups, support groups or any other area where the Church is needed. As Permanent Deacons, we are here to serve and represent the Church where ever the Holy Spirit guides us - with the Bishop's approval. As Permanent Deacons, we serve our Church in our spare time and are not paid employees of the Diocese. We do this out of the love we have for Christ and for you while supporting ourselves through our full time jobs. Bishop Fabbro ordained each of us as the Book of the Gospels was placed in our hands. "Receive the Gospel of Christ whose herald you have become. Believe what you read, teach what you believe, and practice what you teach." This is our mission as ordained Ministers in the Church.



Bishop Fabbro and Bishop Dabrowski invite the faithful to celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary at the Diocesan Shrine of Our Lady of the Rosary in Merlin on Wednesday, August 15. Bishop Fabbro will celebrate Mass at 11:00am followed by lunch. Prior to the Mass, the Sacrament of Reconciliation will be offered.
