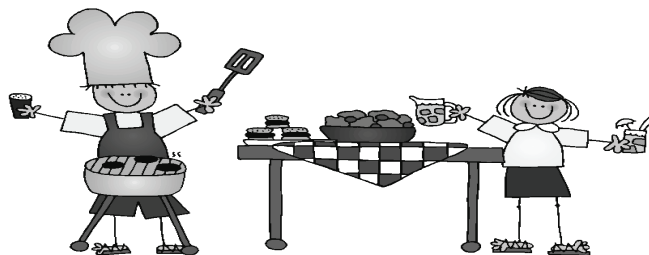

I was able to chaplain the schools of St. Louis, and Cardinal Carter, which was a great joy for me. I was also able to teach catechesis, apologetics, and “discipleship” to a good number of folks. I preached at mass regularly – and sometimes too long; sorry about that. I’m still learning to be concise. I just find it difficult to not say “everything” about God and our faith. I have a special love for the hard work of the CWL who continue to stand for life at the Hospital during the 40 days for life, my classmates who persistently sought to delve deeper in their faith with me, and all the students in the schools, as well as their teachers whom explored our relationship with Christ more deeply. I am mesmerized by the teachers who have collaborated so well with the Church in bringing parents and their students into full communion with the Church – true team work here is a huge encouragement to me.

The time has now come to move to another parish, and I take leave of this community physically, but not in spirit. Be assured of my continued prayers for all of you, and always feel free to “drop-in” if you are in the Windsor area. I will be moving to Corpus Christi Church as an associate pastor, and I will undoubtedly learn new things. I request, sincerely, your prayers as I enter into this new chapter. I pray that I will be able to do God’s will in all things, despite any resistance met by the world.

My encouragement to all of you is to seek to maintain the public acts of piety involved with the various processions. I think it would be wrong to consider these things merely “cultural” because the boldness of taking your faith to the streets is what every Christian is called to do. And you have done it so well, that I cannot help but feel inspired by it. I would encourage others who may not participate in such events to begin, and find courage in the communal support. Your testimony and love for God and the saints will undoubtedly be rewarded by our Father in heaven.

I also know it has been hard for many to wait in line while being backed up on Sherk Street. But consider the visible sign you send to the world in waiting: you are showing people that the Church and our faith has not died, and that the street is backed up because there are “too many people” trying to get to Mass. There is never “too-many-people.” That is the impact that the long-waiting line has had on me during various Masses. For those in Wheatley, I have often been inspired by your devout worship during Mass – and I appreciate the fact that few ever leave early! That is a rare occurrence these days in the Church, and I beg you to keep it up! You will all be missed!

May St. Michael, and Our Lady, Mother of the Eucharist both advocate for you as you continue your pilgrimage home to heaven. May we one day meet again, united by a common Love: Jesus Christ.
