One of the conversations that I often have with parents is the struggle to get their children to Mass. Sometimes we just get out of the habit of going and sometimes it's just easier not to go in order to keep peace with our families.

I recently read an article by Jerry Windley-Daoust called "Doing Mass with Kids: 25+ Strategies for a Better Experience". The following were suggestions that we can use:

#### For Younger Children

Sit up front – sit as close to the front as possible where children can observe what is happening in the liturgy.

Invite participation – children ages three and up can be invited to sing the responses such as the Alleluia and the Great Amen.

Give them something appropriate to look at – bring a picture book for them to look at during Mass.

#### For Older Children

Get them a children's missal - this will help them follow along during Mass.

Encourage children to serve – if they are old enough, encourage them to become altar servers, choir members, etc.

#### For Teens

Help them understand the Mass – encourage them to look at teen-friendly resources available online like **lifeteen.com**. Encourage service in Mass – encourage them to become

lectors and Eucharistic ministers.

Attend a teen-friendly Mass – encourage them to attend a Life Teen Mass (it is our hope that we will begin a Life Teen Mass in October).


