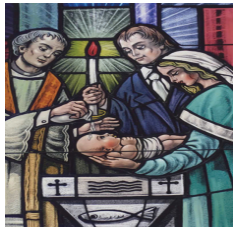

### IN THE FOOTSTEPS OF THE CANADIAN MARTYRS' YOUTH PILGRIMAGE

Young adults ages 18-35 are especially invited to participate in a two-day pilgrimage in the footsteps of the Canadian Martyrs' leading up to our Diocesan Mass at the Martyrs Shrine, Midland, Ontario, on **August 22** with Bishop Fabbro and Dabrowski. 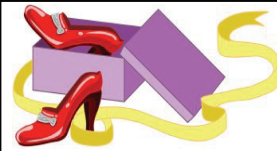
