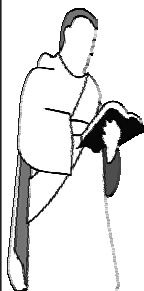

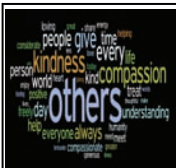

VOCATIONS INFORMATION CORNER

This Month is a focus on Permanent Deacons

The Permanent Diaconate is essentially a ministry of service and charity. The Deacon serves the Church and the diocese in a designated area of service in a hospital or prison or other forms of charitable outreach. The Deacon is assigned to a parish as his liturgical base, where he assists at Mass; preaching, baptizing, presiding at weddings or funerals or in other capacities within the parish. Deacons may be married and their spouse would be involved in the vocation and ministry of their Deacon husband. Deacon formation lasts four years. They share in the sacrament of Orders with Bishops and Priests.
