After prayerful consultation, we are ready to announce the changes that will come into effect this coming **July 1st.**

The new WEEKEND MASS SCHEDULE will be:

Saturday Evening—5:00pm at St. Michael

Sunday Morning—8:00am and 10:00am at St.

Michael and 10:30am at Our Lady of Blessed
Sacram ent.

The new **WEEKDAY MASS SCHEDULE** will be:

Tuesday at 7:00pm and Wednesday to Saturday at 8:00am.

ADORATION will take place on Tuesdays from 9:00am until Benediction at 6:30pm.

The Sacrament of **RECONCILIATION** (**CONFESSION**) will be on Saturday Mornings from 9:00am to 10:00am.

There will also be some changes to the Masses in the NURSING HOMES AND RETIREMENT HOMES. The standard practice in the Diocese of London is that provision is made for the celebration of the Eucharist only in Nursing Homes and not Retirement Homes. After July 1st, the Nursing Homes will continue to have their monthly Mass, while the Retirement Homes will have Mass every other month.
