June 23 - The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of the Lord

This Friday, June 28 is the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus.

There are many sayings that describe the importance of a person's "heart" ("the heart of the matter", "you are my heart", "take it to heart"...) To be devoted to the heart of Jesus is to be devoted to Jesus and his love for us.

Saint Mary Margaret Alacoque while praying in front of the Blessed Sacrament, saw in a vision Jesus who showed her his most Sacred Heart. From the interior of his heart great flames of fire came out which spread in every direction, as if to ignite everyone with which they came in contact. The exterior of his heart was encircled by a crown of thorns which seemed to wound it painfully. The visible wound was inflicted up his Heart by a soldier with a spear, and it was a reminder he gave everything, even the last drop of his blood. From that wound flowed grace — the sacraments through which we encounter God.

Jesus promised that in response to those who consecrate themselves and make reparations to His Sacred Heart:

- He will give them all the graces necessary in their state of life.
- He will establish peace in their homes.
- He will comfort them in all their afflictions.
- He will be their secure refuge during life, and above all, in death.
- He will bestow abundant blessings upon all their undertakings.
- Sinners will find in His Heart the source and infinite ocean of mercy.
- Lukewarm souls shall become fervent.
- · Fervent souls shall quickly mount to high perfection.
- He will bless every place in which an image of His Heart is exposed and honoured.
- He will give to priests the gift of touching the most hardened
- Those who shall promote this devotion shall have their names written in His Heart.
- In the excessive mercy of His Heart that His all-powerful love will grant to all those who receive Holy Communion on the First Fridays in nine consecutive months the grace of final perseverance; they shall not die in His disgrace, nor without receiving their sacraments. His divine Heart shall be their safe refuge in this last moment.

You're welcome to mark this Solemnity on Friday night by joining us for Mass at 7 p.m. The Mass will be a Latin Mass, like it was celebrated before Vatican II, and we will have the choir from St. Benedict Tridentine Catholic Community in Windsor joining us to provide the music.




