From the Desk of Fr. John:

# 1. Family of Parishes – Just over a week ago, in response to the reality of a decreasing number of priests, Bishop Fabbro announced the Families of Parishes across the Diocese. Our Family will include Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Church in Wheatley, St. Michael Parish here in Leamington, St. John de Brebeuf and Companions Parish in Kingsville and Star of the Sea Mission on Pelee Island. The timeline for the creation of this family is not yet established. The Bishop has named two "Pioneer Families" which will be fully implemented in the coming year.

- 2. New Residence The move to a new residence has gone very well. The weather was perfect for the move! A miracle when you consider the number of rainy days we have been experiencing this Spring. Recognizing that we no longer live on site or just next to it we have established a phone number that could be used for emergencies after office hours. The phone is set up in such a way, that even if your call is not answered, if you leave a voice message it will be forwarded to both Fr. Danny and myself via email. The emergency number is 226-315-1932.
- **3. Nine and Eleven Baird Street** After the severance process is complete, these two houses on Baird Street will be placed on the market.
- **4. Fr. Pat's 50**<sup>th</sup> Fr. Pat Fuerth celebrated his 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary with us this past weekend. We thank him for his service to our parish and to our diocese over these 50 years! I would like to thank all those who made it such a success!


### TRINITY SUNDAY


