#### June 9, 2019 - Pentecost Sunday

The Holy Spirit brings to us the gifts of wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, piety and fear of the Lord! The Holy Spirit also provides many charisms in the Body of Christ such as administration, celibacy, craftsmanship, discernment of spirits, encouragement, evangelism, faith, giving, healing, helping, hospitality, intercessory prayer, knowledge, leadership, mercy, missionary, music, pasturing, prophecy, service, speaking in tongues, teaching, poverty, wisdom, and writing

In our parish, we are **blessed** to have so many parishioners with these and so many more tremendous gifts from God! I am so grateful for how blessed we are. May the Holy Spirit keep always appreciative of the ways each of us work together as a team, and always fill us with a spirit of joy and peace.

For those looking for some solid spiritual reading during the summer, I recommend any books by the author, Fr. Jacques Philippe. He is a great spiritual guide in today's modern world.

In this book on the Holy Spirit, he refers to the Spirit as a teacher, because in the gospel today, we hear Jesus assures us: "I have told you this while I am with you. The Advocate, the Holy Spirit, who the Father will send in my name will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you."

### Here are two powerful quotes from that book:

To allow ourselves to be led by the Spirit of God, we need great compliance and adaptability, and we can acquire these little by little by practicing detachment. We should make an effort not to "hang on to" anything, either materially, or affectively, or even spiritually. The detachment we should aim for is not that of saying "to hell with all of it," or of becoming indifferent to everything, or of practicing a sort of forced asceticism and stripping ourselves of everything that makes up our lives; that kind of detachment is not what our Lord normally asks for. We need to keep our hearts in an attitude of detachment, maintaining a sort of freedom, a distance, an inner reserve, that will mean that if some particular thing, or habit, or relationship, or personal plan is taken from us, we don't make a drama out of being deprived of it. Such detachment should be exercised in all aspects of our lives....

If an inspiration truly comes from God, and we silence our fears and consent to it wholeheartedly, in the end we shall be filled with irresistible peace; for the Holy Spirit will not fail to produce such peace in those who allow themselves to be led by him. This peace sometimes dwells only in the very deepest part of the soul, while questions and worries remain at the human and psychological level, but it is there and it is recognizable.

By contrast, if an inspiration comes from the devil or from our own ambitious, selfish, exaggerated need for being recognized by others, and so forth, and we consent to it, it can never leave our heart in total, deep peace. Any peace it does bring will only be superficial, and will soon disappear, to be replaced by disturbance. We may refuse to acknowledge this disturbance and relegate it to the depths of our minds, but it is still there, ready to re-emerge at the moment of truth.
