BABY BOTTLE CAMPAIGN: OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE HOME

During this 40 Days for Life, we are invited to consider supporting new mothers in crisis.

Inspired by our Catholic faith, **Our Lady of Guadalupe Home** is a residence that provides shelter and support to pregnant women and new mothers who have no other place to go.

- Our Lady of Guadalupe Home will serve new mothers who are in crisis but have no place to live due to unfortunate circumstances or lack of support from loved ones. They welcome all women of any race or religion and will provide shelter, support and counsel to new mothers in crisis for up to a year.
- Our Lady of Guadalupe Non-Profit Home is a registered charity, dependent on Divine Providence to meet our needs: food, household upkeep and most importantly, salaries.
- We are unique in that we have paid staff on duty 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

Our Lady of Guadalupe depends on God to inspire good people to help provide the means to continue their program for new mothers in crisis.

Please take a baby bottle home and fill it with change or bills or a cheque as the Lord inspires you, and return it by Easter (you can drop it in the collection basket or drop it off at the office).
