March 3, 2019 - Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time

In a few days we will begin the season of Lent. Lent begins with Ash Wednesday. On that day many Christians receive a cross of ashes on their foreheads. This powerful sign has been used by God's people for hundreds of years. The cross of ashes tells friends and neighbours that we know we are not perfect. We do not always love God as we should, and we do not always act with love and care toward those around us. On Ash Wednesday we own up to that and begin a six-week period of prayer, reflection, and almsgiving.

The cross is a sign of suffering. Suffering that can strengthen and redeem. Ashes are a sign of death-the event that will someday bring each of us face to face with our loving and forgiving God.

In ancient times people showed sorrow by wearing humble clothes made of sackcloth - plain, inexpensive cloth used for grain sacks, like burlap. They also put ashes on their heads. As Christians we still use ashes as a sign of sorrow for offending God through our selfish acts.

During Lent we especially focus on three aspects-fasting, prayer and almsgiving. Fasting is a biblical discipline that can be found in scripture. Christ expected his disciples to fast (Mt 9:14-15) and issued instructions for how they should do so (Mt 6:16-18). We fast and abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and on Fridays during Lent. Many Catholics also abstain from meat every Friday during the year.


The disciple of fasting and prayer during Lent reminds us of the 40 days that Jesus spent in the desert.

During Lent we are called to give alms. The word "alms" comes from the Greek word for "compassion." Compassion is the ability to feel what someone else is feeling. We give money to the poor; bring in canned good or clothes. We also show compassion by helping those in need.

This Lent I encourage you to enter into this season preparing your hearts to encounter the risen Lord at Easter.

Don't forget to join us for our Pancake Supper being held on March 5 from 6:00 to 7:30 pm in the Church Hall.






