1. Building Issues:

Yes, the roof above that area of the building is leaking! Also we have a leak in the roof above the men's washroom on the north side of the building. I am hoping that these roof issues will be resolved soon!

Also, with the recent snow melt, a portion of the eavestrough above the north car ramp has been ripped off. Any moisture from the roof is now splashing directly on the car ramp. If we have below freezing temperatures, this area may become quite dangerous! Please use the stairs or the wheelchair ramp and avoid this area. Thanks!

During Lent we are gathering after the 7:00pm Mass on Tuesdays to reflect on the readings of the coming Sunday. Even if you have not come to any so far during Lent, you might consider coming to the next one. They take place in the Conference Room on the second floor of the office building.
