"Pentecost" comes from the Greek language and means "fifty": Fifty days after our Lord's resurrection, God the Holy Spirit descended upon the apostles who began with great courage to proclaim the Good News of our salvation, that **Jesus is Lord, risen from the dead.** The number "50" is symbolic and is rooted in the Feast of Weeks about the Jewish people, a time of harvesting the fruits of the earth. It indicates "**more than enough**" ["7" already a symbol for fullness; "7 x 7 = 49, plus 1 = **Fifty**"]

Today is the "**birthday of the church**", when the apostles and the newly baptized Christians came out in public with the Good News and spread this News throughout the world, incorporating new followers of Jesus into his risen body, the Church, by the power of the Holy Spirit who engaged them in the mission of continuing the evangelization of all cultures.

We pray today for a fresh outpouring of grace, the life-giving fire of the Holy Spirit, so that we may fearlessly **bring God into the public picture of our daily life and cultures.** We are given "more than enough" grace and power to do this. Like the apostles, we work together as one church, one community of faith, who are given all the means to accomplish our mission to witness to our Catholic faith and to bring the culture of life to birth in our Canadian milieu.

Today the *Festa do Espírito Santo* is celebrated by many of our fellow parishioners who come from the Portuguese culture, a Festival that is a public display of Catholic Faith that is rooted in family life and prayer. May all of us be drawn into the catholic unity of Faith as we all celebrate the birthday of the Church.

CONGRATULATIONS to all of our children receiving Our Lord in their First Holy Communion this weekend and to all of our couples soon to seal their engagements in the Sacrament of Marriage.

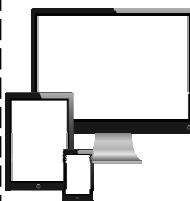

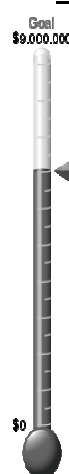
