In him we live and move and have our being (words of
St. Paul in Acts 17:28)

St. Augustine shared with us this prayer which he
composed in his Confessions after a life-time of searching
for God:

*Late have I loved you, O beauty so ancient and so new,
late have I loved you.*

*You were within me, but I was outside, and it was there
that I searched for you.*

*In my unloveliness I plunged into the lovely things you
created.*

You were with me, but I was not with you.

*Created things kept me from you; yet if they had not been
in you, they would have no being at all.*

On this great feast we are lead to contemplate and worship
the divine life of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, a
life of intimate communion, and to share in this life
through the grace of God.

In our parish family this Feast of God occurs in a time of
many transitions:

- The funeral Mass for Father Vince Gleeson, once the
pastor of St. Michael's, was well attended by some of our
parishioners and by many priests and deacons in the
diocese. May he rest in Peace.

- Father Christian Gonzalez Campos, FMM, is called
home to Guatemala where he will exercise his priestly
ministry. Father Eduardo Barrera, from the same Mission-
ary Society, will be his successor, responsible mainly for
overseeing our parish's ministry to migrant workers of
Hispanic cultures and language. Thanks go out to so many
who have worked in our "Outreach to Migrant Ministry"
committee who have helped Father Christian and have
provided hospitality and encouragement to many of our
migrant parishioners who are far from their homes and
families. Father Christian's 'farewell' Mass will be
celebrated on Sunday, June 5th, at 3:00 p.m.

- Father Christopher Pietraszko is moving to Corpus
Christi Parish in Windsor, after two years with us. His
gifts for preaching and for apologetics have touched many
of us and our prayers go with him as he shares his priestly
ministry within a new parish family. We will celebrate a

'farewell' Mass with him on Wednesday evening at 7:00 p.m. on June 29, the Feast of Saint Peter and Saint Paul. His successor as parochial vicar has been named in the person of Father Pedro Zúñiga, also a member of the Missionary Society from Guatemala, who has a gift for languages: Spanish, English and Italian.

Father Danny and I are both looking forward to working with these new priest associates, as are all the members of our pastoral team and staff, and we know that our priestly fraternity with Father Christian and Father Chris will continue well beyond our parish boundaries.

- A new Episcopal Vicar for Essex and Windsor combined has been named: Father Dan Bombardier who will also be the Pastor of St. John Vianney. The joining of our two deaneries is part of the overall plan of the bishop to develop our outreach in ministry through the collaboration of groups of parish families. Our parish family will eventually expand to include St. John de Brébeuf, Kingsville, Star of the Sea, Pelee Island, and continue to gather fellow parishioners in Wheatley at Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament Church.

- Our Parish Pastoral Council is forming plans for the transition of the Liturgy from St. Joseph's to the new St. Michael's which will probably take place in the Fall, as the work on it is progressing according to plan. This week we received the budget for all the kitchen equipment and for the audio-visual technology, which will be covered from the budget's cash allowance. Simone and Father Danny will soon be meeting with Father Michael Bechard to receive advice regarding the appropriate liturgies that frame this transition upon the closure of St. Joseph's church as a worship place to the consecration of St. Michael's church.

- Before the end of the school year, we will be asking the young people in all the grades, JK to Grade 12 to write their names to be included in the time-capsule already crafted by Chad Gillett, grandson of Mr. Gillett who made the first one. It will include the items from the old time-capsule from 1922 and 1954 and will be installed inside at the foot of the old Cross in the vestibule of the new building.

- TRANSITIONS are always challenging, exciting and also at times at little disconcerting. Please pray that we move together as one parish family and keep our eyes focused on the Lord who continues to send us out to our daily mission to live our faith with courage and conviction.

You will be receiving a mailing which gives an update regarding our financing of this building project. Please help so that we do not leave a debt behind us. We are now in a loan position as we pay the bills along the way.

Our annual parish meeting is usually held in June, but we will plan to move it this year to the Fall in our new facility, once it is ready. Plan on coming out to our annual parish picnic that is combined with our volunteer appreciation event on Sunday, July 17th which will begin with a special outdoor Mass on the Kiwanis grounds on Seacliff Drive west at 3:00 p.m. The Sunday Mass at 7:00 p.m. will be cancelled that evening.
