May 26, 2019-Sixth Sunday of Easter

A brief history of the Holy Spirit Festival and the origin of the crowning ceremony:

At one time during Queen Saint Isabel's reign, there was a terrible famine in Portugal. The Queen completed all her funds while seeking food for her people and she had no financial resources left except her Crown, the symbol of her royal status. One morning at Mass, she promised the Holy Spirit, "I will give my Crown to the church if you send me a miracle so my people will be relieved of their hunger." As she left the church, she saw ships coming into the harbour loaded with wheat and corn! For over 700 years Portuguese people have celebrated this event in the Festa do Espirito Santo or Feast of the Holy Spirit; to intercede in time of danger or calamities.

The Crown or "Coroa" consists of three individual pieces. The Scepter of the Crown is accented by a dove, the symbol of the Holy Spirit whose love was so manifested in Queen Saint Isabel's life. The Crown has a double significance as it represents both the supreme dominion of the Holy Spirit and the royalty of Queen Saint Isabel. The Plate, serving as a stand for the Crown and the Scepter, represents the people. If we are to be true followers of Jesus Christ, we must serve others. As a plate holds food which is given to the hungry, so are we called to actively serve like Queen Saint Isabel; not only to be touched by God's Holy Spirit, but to see that divine transformation into the visible reality of serving others in their spiritual, physical, and emotional needs.

The Holy Spirit Festival will be celebrated at St. Michael's Parish on June 9th at 12:00pm with a Bilingual Portuguese-English Mass followed by a procession and meal at the Portuguese Club. All are invited to attend and participate in this celebration.
