#### The Ascension of Our Lord into Heaven - May 8, 2016

We recall and relive in the celebration of holy Mass today the beginning of Jesus' Passion with his agony in the garden and his glorification at the same Mount of Olives from where he enters in the fullness of his risen humanity into the presence of his Father in heaven. Where are we to look today for him? Are we to look down on the ground, sad, feeling his absence, or are we to look up to the sky, trying to see where he has gone? Or do we rather look outwards, towards every human person who is on the same journey as we are, eager to share with them the joy of knowing Jesus? Are we daily aiming to be ready to be taken up with him into heaven? We pray with the Church today: draw us after you. Help us to ascend with you to dwell in heaven where you have gone to prepare a place for all of us. May we detach ourselves from all passing earthly things so that we may seek only the joys that are true and lasting. May we be where we know with the certainty of faith that your Sacred Humanity has ascended.

We believe that only by him can we enter heaven: no man can enter into the Holy of Holies except with him. No creature can enjoy eternal happiness except by following Jesus; it was his merits that won for us infinite beatitude. In our celebration of the Sacrifice of the Mass we are given a full taste of the glory he wills to bestow on us. And throughout eternity we shall say to him: O Jesus, it is through you, through your blood shed for us that we are before the Face of God. It is your sacrifice, your immolation that has gained for us in every moment of our life's journey, the hope of glory and beatitude: to you, O Lamb who offered yourself as the unique Priest, mediator between God and humanity, be all honour, all praise, all thanksgiving!


