At the climax of the Jubilee Year of Mercy, we come with open hearts and minds to the invitation of God to embrace Jesus, the Universal King of history and place. This is an important celebration as it challenges and exorcizes every human and satanic abuse of power imaginable. It was inaugurated by Pope Pius XI in 1925 at a time of nations and states abusing their power over others, particularly the rising threat of despotism in the Nazi movement. The Feast relives the fact that Jesus is our Crucified King who brings victory through his suffering and death of the Cross, where he is 'enthroned' and on whose head sits the Crown of thorns. In him the kingdom of God reigns and extends outwards to all creation: like rocks and trees, to animals, and to angels, to human beings who stride every aspect of existence. They are invited to his kingdom through Him, with Him and in Him.

Todays' Mass describes Jesus' Kingdom as a kingdom of truth and life, a kingdom of holiness and grace, a kingdom of justice, love and peace.

In the Gospel we see Jesus enthroned on the Cross, with the inscription above his Head: I N R I: "Jesus of Nazareth, King of the Jews". This moment of suffering and pain which he embraces in total fidelity to God opens the vision of his enthronement at the right hand of God the Father. We pray: THY KINDGOM COME! Not the kingdom of this world that is empowered at the expense of truth, life, holiness and grace, justice, love and peace. We pray THY KINGDOM COME as we reject the power play of the culture that would make us victims to the machinations of the powers of this world, and indeed that power of the fallen angels who would trick us into abandoning our Father in Heaven and losing our freedom to be all we are in Christ. The suffering and pain we GO THROUGH is momentary as we join ourselves to him and cling to his kingdom, his mercy and love, as did the repentant thief crucified next to Jesus. He is showing us, as we gaze upon him, crucified King of the Universe, how to bring about his kingdom, how to use our power to advance his Kingdom and let go of our sins of abuse of the power we are given. The greatest and only true gift we have is the gift of his rule of love and justice in all our human experience, and so we pray over and over again: THY KINGDOM COME ... THY WILL BE DONE, ON EARTH AS IT IS IN HEAVEN a prayer that is the Father's invitation to us. COME ... to place ourselves in complete trust inside the experience of Jesus who overcomes the powers that would destroy us and all creation by his steadfast offer of mercy and justice.


