KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS IN OUR PARISH

In 1882, Fr. Michael McGivney (now Venerable) saw the need to assist widows and orphans in New Haven Connecticut. He called together a small group which led to the formation of the Knights of Columbus. It also now has one of the largest Insurance companies in North America with a triple "A" rating.

The organization has expanded to over 2 million Rev. Kazimierz Lorencowicz, C.S.M.A. Ext 225 members in North America, the Philippines and many countries in Europe and Asia.

St. Michael's Council 4501 was chartered in 1967. While our main focus is to support our parish, we also reach out by offering assistance to: youth through sporting and scholarships, our local high school, seniors and the community at large.

To date we have contributed over \$650,000.00 towards the building of our new St. Michael's Church. We also recently made a donation of \$14,500 to the Leamington Hospice. We continuously record over 6,000 volunteer hours annually, supporting the parish and many other functions in our community.


