The Solemnity of Christ the King - November 25, 2018

From Fr. Tom...

Fr. Michael Ryan once pointed out that most of us have some kind of power in our lives... husbands and wives exercise power over one another and over their children. Teachers exercise power, not only over the wills, but also over the minds of children. Employers exercise power over their employee's livelihood and the social atmosphere in which they have to live each day. Many adults exercise power over the lives of others by the way they spend or invest their money.

How should we use power? We should use it for the good of others; we should use it to help those who lack power; we should use it to create a just society; we should use it to forgive and save.

There are times power has been abused. In the early 19th century, Communist and Fascist governments were springing up in Europe, and many political leaders were claiming that every domain of life is subject to the power of the government. At that time, Pope Pius XI wanted to bring to the attention of the world that all power is subject to the power of God, so he started the **Feast of Christ the King** to remind us what true power looks like.

On this feast of Christ the King, we can consecrate ourselves to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. To consecrate is to set something apart from other things or ways of life for God. This is a way to give recognition to the kingship of Christ over our families, our homes, and our work.

Here is a beautiful prayer of consecration by Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque:

O Sacred Heart of Jesus, to You I consecrate and offer up my person and my life, my actions, trials and sufferings, that my entire being may henceforth only be employed in loving, honoring and glorifying You. This is my irrevocable will, to belong entirely to You, and to do all for Your love, renouncing with my whole heart all that can displease You.

I take You, O Sacred Heart, for the sole object of my love, the protection of my life, the pledge of my salvation, the remedy of my frailty and inconstancy, the reparation for all the defects of my life, and my secure refuge at the hour of my death. Be You O merciful Heart, my justification before God Your Father, and screen me from His anger which I have so justly merited. I fear all from my own weakness and malice but placing my entire confidence in You, O Heart of Love. I hope from Your

infinite Goodness. Annihilate in me all that can displease or resist You. Imprint Your pure love so deeply in my heart that I may never forget You or be separated from You.

I beseech You, through Your infinite Goodness, grant that my name be engraved upon Your Heart, for in this I place all my happiness and all my glory, to live and to die as one of Your devoted servants. Amen.
