NOVEMBER 3, 2019 - 31st Sunday in Ordinary Time

A few years ago I made a pilgrimage to Israel. It was amazing to walk the same streets that Jesus did. As I read today's gospel, I remember seeing the tree where Zacchaeus climbed to get a better view. There have been many times in ministry where I've had to change where I stand to get a different perspective in order to better see what is going on.

We may never know what Zacchaeus was truly thinking and feeling when he climbed that tree. The gospel does tell us that Zacchaeus was so moved by Jesus that he promised to give half of his wealth to the poor and more than repay the people he had extorted money from. Experiencing Jesus' love converted his heart and called him to action.

There have been many times at the parish that I've seen the same thing happen. The last few months have proven that when we take action, new programs and ministries begin. Parishioners have been inspired to come forward to give of their time, talent and treasure. Seeing this has certainly inspired me and has given me hope for our growing church.

Parishioners have never disappointed me when I've come to them asking for some help, which I am once again doing. We are looking for some donations for the next COR weekend. Some of the items needed are:

8 large bags of whole wheat buns, 70 dinner rolls, 5 loaves of bread (white or whole wheat), 30-40 lbs. of potatoes, one 3 kg. bag of frozen mixed vegetables, one 5 lb. bag of carrots, 2 bunches of celery, 2 large onions, 7 heads of lettuce, 2 green onions, one bag of radishes, 1 lb. of butter, 1 large tub of margarine, one 4 litre bag of milk, one large powdered parmesan cheese, one lb. of coffee, one box of tea, 5 cartons of grape juice (white and/or purple), 10 bottles of Spritz Up, one box of cornstarch, 4 boxes of liquid chicken broth, one box of liquid beef broth, 2-50 foot packages of aluminum foil, 2 cans of cooking spray, 100 large paper plates, 100 small paper plates, 100 plastic cups, 10 boxes of Kleenex, 100 dinner napkins.

The above list helps offset the cost of the COR weekend to make it affordable for the young people attending. If you can help in any way, please sign up on the flyer posted at the back of the church by placing your name next to the item that you will be donating. All donated items must be brought to the church by Thursday, November 7th.


PRAY TO END ABORTION During the 40 Days For Life fall campaign,


