I would like to thank all those who came out for Life Chain in Leamington and Kingsville on Sunday. In Kingsville there were 21 participants this year, which was up by 4 people from last year. The numbers doubled in Leamington from 17 last year to 34 this year. With Essex at 81 and Harrow at 15, the county numbers added up to 151. As well, 176 pro-life supporters took part in four Windsor locations. This means that Windsor-Essex County Right to Life had a combined 327 prayer warriors for unborn babies on the streets between 2:30 and 3:30 pm on Sunday! By the grace of God our witness will have made a difference to someone.


