Bishop Fabbro has designated this year as a year of prayer. In our Catholic tradition, October is known as the month of the rosary. The rosary has roots in several early Christian traditions. Third century Christian hermits and monks in Egypt (known as Desert Fathers) used stones and later prayer ropes to keep track when praying the 150 psalms.

So why do we use rosary beads to pray? While the exact origin of prayer beads are unknown; men and women of many faiths (Hindus, Greeks, Buddhists, and more), use beads to pray. The word bead in English means prayer.

It is widely believed that in 1214, St. Dominic had a vision of Mary where she presented him with a rosary-both the beads and prayers to be prayed.

St. Dominic had a great devotion to Mary and the rosary which he promoted wherever he travelled to preach. He encouraged Catholics to gather in small groups to pray together.

The first recorded use of the "rosary" did not appear until the year 1597. The version of the Hail Mary we use today was given official approval in 1568. Pope Paul VI said that when we pray the rosary we can experience the key moments of the Gospel by focusing on the mysteries of the rosary.

In 1917, Mary appeared to the shepherd children in Fatima and asked them to pray the rosary every day. In July of that year, Mary asked the children to add a short prayer at the end of each decade which said "Oh my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell; lead all souls to heaven, especially those in most need of thy mercy".

Praying the rosary is a great spiritual practice. In saying that, we invite you to join us as we pray the Living Rosary on Friday, October 11 at 7:00pm in St. Michael's Church. We will need 59 people to create a rosary around the church. That is one person per bead of the rosary. This is a great event for the whole family. For those interested in being part of the rosary, there will be a short "rehearsal" on Wednesday, October 9 at 7:00pm.

I am looking forward to praying with you.


