## **Twenty-fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

The famous parables of forgiveness and reconciliation from Luke's Gospel are proclaimed this weekend. We need to practice forgiveness of others, of ourselves and of those who have hurt or harmed us. Morning and evening we can take a few minutes to let go of our egotistic attachments and forgive by letting go, speaking the truth with compassion and love.

Here is another ministry in our diocese ... The Catholic's Divorce Survival Guide:

In the Fall of 2015, the Diocese of London began an exciting, new ministry to men and women who have suffered from separation and divorce. The **Catholic's Divorce Survival Guide** is a twelve-week program featuring thirty-minute DVD sessions each week that cover topics of shock, denial, anger, grief, guilt, forgiveness, money, the kids, the ex-spouse, annulment, dating, sexuality, spirituality, remarriage or staying single, and much more. Whether you became separated or divorced one year ago or ten years ago, the program offers valuable insight for everyone. This program is based on the teachings of the Catholic Church and open to anyone who needs comfort, support and clarity after a separation or divorce.

In the Fall of 2015 and the Spring of 2016, approximately 30 participants were blessed with the ability to share their stories and support each other while expressing a common faith. Two of these participants had this to say ...

*"A Faith filled, honest group of individuals who have all lived a tragic and life-changing experience within their marriage: separation and/or divorce. We gather over 12 weeks to share our story, grow and learn to deepen our faith, even after such a life-altering experience. We found hope to trust in God and in our shared experience. We will continue to walk in Faith, trusting God's plan."*

*"As a former Protestant, this series has illuminated me about the Roman Catholic position on marriage and divorce. I have learned about some other Roman Catholic teachings. The group experience supported me and I enjoyed our sharing sessions. I am not alone."*

### Vocation as a Single Person



The laity has a significant role in our Church today. We are called to social ministry to fulfill our baptismal responsibility. By deepening our spiritual life, we can assess our God-given talents and discern how best to offer these in service to Jesus Christ. Single persons can serve for a certain

number of years as lay missionary to our needy world; putting their faith into action in our country in parishes, schools, social agencies and hospitals, soup kitchens and child-care centres. They can be teachers, construction workers, home care aides, accountants, etc.. Single people can serve in a church-related career such as religious education, campus ministers or prison ministers.

Associates may be single men or women who want to enrich their Christian life by an affiliation with a religious community of priests, brothers or sisters.

The Vocation of a Single Consecrated Secular is a vocation in and of the world. Members take vows of poverty, celibacy, and obedience but do not wear distinctive attire or live in a community as do members of religious orders, they may live alone or with family

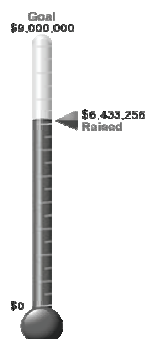
