The Divine Mercy Chaplet and Novena:

"Mankind will not have peace until it turns with trust to God's Mercy." (Jesus to St. Faustina)

The Divine Mercy Novena prayers were given to St. Faustina by Jesus in private revelations. St. Faustina transcribed what Jesus dictated, beginning on Good Friday and ending on the eve of Divine Mercy Sunday - a nine day novena. It became her responsibility to deliver to the world the message of the Divine Mercy of God.

In October 2006, a small group of St. Michael's parishioners came together with a common desire to introduce souls to the Mercy of God. Most of these people were familiar with the Divine Mercy Chaplet having seen it on EWTN and they were eager to establish it in the parish. One can only believe that Jesus was paving the way; as with perfect timing, someone donated a Divine Mercy picture. The music for the chaplet was ordered and the words for the nine-day novena (including a Portuguese translation.) were copied for all participants. Within two weeks, the Divine Mercy Chaplet was being sung in St. Michael's church every Friday at 3:00pm.

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament begins at 2:30pm, the chaplet is sung at 3:00pm and Benediction takes place immediately after recitation of the Praises of the Divine Mercy.

Parishioners are encouraged to bring their own prayer intentions to Divine Mercy. Words from the chaplet, "Have mercy on us and on the whole world", remind us to pray for a world in turmoil.

Here is a time for song, adoration and meditation - a powerful and touching prayer which brings participants closer to Christ. God is waiting for you to respond to His generous offer and place your trust in His Divine Mercy. Come, pray with us!
