### **Twenty-Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time September 17, 2017**

Growing up it seemed like there were days that my brothers and I would constantly fight, much to the displeasure of my parents. We would fight over silly things like when we would switch the T.V. channel when the others were watching, taking things that didn't belong to us, or even calling each other names. Some days the list would go on and on . . . I know some of these things were quite petty. Our dislike for something that hurt us would create anger and we would hold on to that anger making us want to hurt each other more.

One day my brother while crossing the street was hit by a car. The police called notifying us of what had happened and that he was being transported to the hospital. In that moment of learning my brother was hurt, all my anger dispelled into fear. Fear of losing him.

Today's Gospel addresses "How often must I forgive?" Sometimes we don't feel like forgiving someone especially when we've been hurt. We think that if we forgive someone that it means they didn't really hurt us, or that it's okay for them to do it again.

Forgiveness is not about letting other people walk all over you. It's a decision to acknowledge the hurt someone has done to you and not desire them to hurt others in return. It's a choice for peace in your heart, instead of revenge. You might make the choice to forgive someone, but still not like them. Or you might like them, but not what they did.

In the end, my brother was fine, just a little sore. I learned that day that holding onto hurt was not how we should show love to those around us. Even today my brothers and I still disagree but we know that reaching out in love is more important than any hurt that we hold onto. Forgiveness is the only way to bring healing to any disagreement.

So I ask you: (1) Are there any situations in your life right now where you are holding onto anger or a grudge against someone? (2) Where in your own life do you need to be forgiven? (3) Have you brought that to God?
