Twenty-fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

What happened to the servant in today's Gospel? (Luke 16:1-3) The habit of greed for money had grown so deep in him and he had become so used to a dishonest way of life that he couldn't change. That is how it is with passions and habits. In the beginning, before they have sunk deep roots, it is easy to pull them out. But if we allow them to sink deep roots, it becomes virtually impossible to rid ourselves of them. Jesus shows how greed for money can ruin a person, and insists that we can't serve both God and money. What seems impossible for us can become possible with the help of God's grace. We need only to get the advice we need and the help of others' prayers, and to co-operate with the gracious love and mercy of God. We pray: *God of power and love, confirm us in your service and help us to bear witness to you in the society in which we live. We ask this through Christ our Lord.*

Update about our refugee family awaiting permission to come under our sponsorship from Lebanon where they now are - unable to work, and anxious to begin a new life in this, our land of freedom.

There has been a long delay in the process of Canada immigration processing this request for re-settlement of this Christian family with four children. Our committee (17 persons, chaired by Frank Moauro) and the head of the diocesan refugee office, Mr. Gilbert Iamuremye, are frustrated with the delay. It seems that the rules changed from the first communication we had about this family, and they were put on the back of the line of petitioners by immigration authorities who were concentrating on the 25,000 Syrian refugees promised by Prime Minister Trudeau. Our committee met last week to respond to the offer made by Gilbert that we could transfer our support to another family and receive them in a shorter time, but we feel committed to our original sponsorship of the Hanna family. Through Valere Gaspard who is on our committee, we are in direct contact with the family, as Valere is able to converse by phone in Arabic with them. They are all healthy, unable to work in Lebanon and living away from the refugee camp where anti-Christian threat is rife. The Christian area in Lebanon took in a lot of Christian refugees from Iraq. It looks like the Canadian Embassy in Lebanon is giving priority to refugees in no-man's land; those who have some financial resources and those living in apartments are not given priority. Our hope is that our immigration policies have not fallen into the trap of anti-Christian discrimination, and are ready to make representation with our Members of Parliament.

this family when they do arrive, and storage space has been offered as well. Holy Name of Jesus Parish in Essex has teamed up with us and already committed a large sum of money to help with the financial backing we need. As well, the schools: St. Louis and Queen of Peace had campaigns to raise funds last year. Our committee, though frustrated, remains loyal to the promise we made to give this family a new start where they will be free of persecution because of their Christianity. We feel as though the parish as a whole would feel the same way. Please pray for the doors to open for them as soon as possible. (Just to mention: some time ago I was privileged to help a Mexican couple obtain permission for refugee and landed immigrant status, and as we had to wait for a decision and were quite worried, we prayed to two saints, known as door openers: Saint (Brother) Andre of Montreal, and Santo Toribio Romo of Mexico—whose prayers were answered!)

Please keep our young adults in your prayers as they need to discern their God-given vocations.

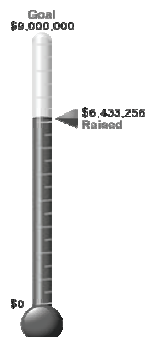
