

For Easter:

All creation is reborn with the new Adam who rises from the tomb. During the next fifty days as we move toward Pentecost. will contemplate the post-Easter we manifestations of Jesus, the meaning of His Death and Resurrection in our own lives, and our call to be Christ's body through which He continues to touch human pain and heal broken hearts.

In the first reading on Easter Sunday Peter preaches the basic catechism of the early Christian faith. He recalls the baptism and Jesus's anointing with the "Holy Spirit and power". The power was given to Jesus not to lord it over anyone, but to concretely manifest God's love by doing good, healing, and by driving out demons. Peter and the Apostles were eye witnesses to all Jesus's healing and teaching which increased their authority. They also "ate and drank with Him" after the Resurrection and were commissioned by Jesus to "preach to the people".

In the second reading, Paul reminds us that Jesus has not risen alone: we who have died with Him in Baptism, have also risen to new life! Besides celebrating a historical event, Easter announces the ever-present, mysterious reality that we "have been raised with Christ". But Easter also reminds us we must never take that reality for granted. Faith is not magic. It always requires response to God's generous initiative, a response which we must do and must do it now. "Seek the things that are above". Put our sinful ways behind us and embrace the risen life we've begun to live, even if only partially, here in this life. "For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God" tells a double truth: we are already living the risen life of the Kingdom but not fully. There is joy but also moral imperative in those words – if we want to be ready when Christ comes!




