For Second Sunday of Easter - Divine Mercy Sunday:

The first reading from Acts describes the early Christian community. The focus of their lives is threefold. First is the teaching of the Apostles – the bedrock of their faith because the Apostles are a direct link to Jesus. Second is the community living in common – they shared their material resources so that all are cared for and none is in need. And finally, they gather to break bread, the Eucharistic meal, shared in memory of Jesus.

In the Gospel we meet disciples huddled behind locked doors for fear of the Jewish authorities. Their fear is overshadowed by the miraculous as Jesus suddenly appears in their midst. He addresses their anxiety and eroded faith. The disciples rejoice after they see Jesus' wounds which prove His identity. Thomas also needs the visual confirmation to increase his faith. When Jesus comes again, Thomas truly contrite, speaks from the deepest part of his being, for his eyes are suddenly opened and he recognizes Jesus without ever touching the wounds. "Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have come to believe."

Millions of pilgrims travelled to Rome this weekend to participate in the Canonization of Pope John XXIII and Pope John Paul II. It is a truly historic event in the life of the universal Church. Bishop Douglas Crosby is among them. The ceremonies take place at St. Peter's Basilica on Divine Mercy Sunday (Second Sunday of Easter), April 27th. We pray in thanksgiving for this unique moment of grace for the entire Church.

As John XXIII and John Paul II are canonized, it is a reminder for us who saints are: The witnesses who have




