For the 22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time:

In the first reading our attention is drawn to the fact that humility leads to favor in the sight of God and that those who are greatest should be servants of all. These are familiar themes in Christian teaching. One who glories in his or her own good work can't at the same time give glory to God. In making his points, Sirach employs the same humility he endorses. His style is simple and humble, comprised of two-line epigrams or wise sayings that all speak of the benefits of humility, both in the conduct of secular "tasks" and in the service of the Lord.

In the second reading, the author of Hebrews contrasts the old Covenant made in the midst of the thunder and fire of Mount Sinai, a sight that filled the people with fear of God and made them want to shut their ears to block God's fearful voice, with the new Covenant made under wholly different circumstances. We stand with Christ at Mount Zion in the company of innumerable Angels and saints. Rather than fear, this setting fills us with peace for we see those who went before us assembled in "festal gathering." We are not alone before God, we are in the company of Jesus, the mediator, who intercedes for us and turns what might be fearful into an experience of safety, solace, and communion! It is a hopeful message to be spoken in hope-filled joy!
