Reflection on the Second Reading from James 5: 7-10

As the Church nears the celebration of Jesus' birth the readings increasingly claim that the event "fulfills" Israel's Scriptures. This view flows from the earliest Christians, immersed in the Jewish perspective that God's plan of salvation unfolded in their communal life of relationship with God. As time passed, new events revealed deeper meanings of God's Word, often meanings undreamed in centuries past. The thoroughly Jewish Apostle to the Gentiles speaks from this perspective at the beginning of the Letter to the Romans.

What Paul proclaims to the Church at Rome is the "gospel of God", the good news of salvation of Christ. By proclaiming that his message fulfills the promise of the Scriptures, the Apostle underscores its authenticity. Jesus is revealed as the long-awaited "Son of David," the ideal ruler who inaugurates God's final reign over all things. In raising Jesus from death, God further reveals Christ as "Son of God" in a new sense; he is not only an earthly king adopted by God (Psalm 2:6-7), but shares the fullness of divine Spirit. Paul announces that this Christ who Fulfills Israel's Scriptures called him to proclaim that astonishing message: Jesus, Son of David and Son of God, realizes the hopes of Gentiles as well. All are called to be holy in Christ Jesus, for all are called to belong to him.
