

### Reflection on the Second Reading (Hebrews 10:5 -10)

The author of the Letter to the Hebrews addresses the theme of salvation by comparing the ultimate efficacy of Christ's sacrifice with the inefficacy of the sacrifices of the first covenant. He presents a Christological interpretation of Psalm 40 to indicate the perfect submission to the will of the Father who presided over Christ's life and work. The sacrifices and expiatory victims prescribed by the first covenant do not earn salvation. Christ's coming into the world replaced the former offerings with the sacrifice of fulfilling God's will, with the perfect offering, once and for all, of his own body, which sanctifies us. The author puts in Christ's mouth the strong declaration of his mission "I come to do your will, O God." In becoming flesh, Jesus showed how to live according to God's will. The author motivates the believer to do God's will, which is what Jesus Christ came to instill in his people. Excerpt: 2019 Workbook for Lectors, Gospel Readers & Proclaimers of the Word.


Good Shepherd Catechesis program is closed for the Christmas break and will resume again on January 14th.

Youth Group does not meet over Christmas break. Next meeting for everyone is Jan. 11<sup>th</sup>. It is a fun night so bring a friend!!



engaging, and truly instructive that you will find yourself smiling as you read it, and you'll be amazed at what you retain." Elizabeth Scalia.




