Today, when the feast usually falls on the Sunday after Christmas, it extends the celebrations of the Nativity, putting new emphasis on the humanity of Jesus and on the gift of divine life offered to all of us.

As we celebrate this feast we are invited to contemplate the potential of our own relationships, natural, created, extended and extraordinary, united in the bound of love.
