

#### For Second Sunday of Advent:

Chapters 40-55 of the Book of Isaiah were written towards the end of Israel's exile in Babylon, around 550 BC. The author is referred to as Second Isaiah. Today's reading is his opening section. He prophesied an almost unthinkable message of hope to the captive Israelites: the time of exile had come to a close. God had forgiven Israel her sins, and was calling Israel back to the Promised Land. Israel's long wait in exile, spanning two generations, was finally coming to an end.

The words of comfort ("Comfort, o comfort my people, says your God. Speak tenderly to Jerusalem, and cry to her that she has served her term...") require a response ("In the wilderness prepare the way of the Lord, make straight in the desert a highway for our God...."). Only then the "glory of the Lord shall be revealed, and all people shall see it together."

The author of the Second Letter of Peter addresses the concerns of a delay in Christ's second coming. He assures that "the Lord is not slow about His promise." Time is a matter of perspective. He reminds the readers of the tradition they received about the return of Christ: "the day of the Lord will come like a thief." So, be prepared by living a good and holy life until that day when the Lord does return in glory.

#### Bible studies at our Parish:

The Tuesday afternoon Bible Study group has completed a very successful study of the Book of Revelation. Seventeen parishioners and non-parishioners met for approx. 1.5 - 2hours of study. Lots of participation and sharing with the final conclusion that this book is all about Jesus and the celebration of the Eucharist.

Later in March afternoon sessions will resume. The meeting day will change to Thursdays and the topic will be "The Prophets".

The Monday night Bible Study group is looking at the 14 books from the Bible that carry the story line. The two last sessions covered the Book of Exodus, and especially the connections to the New Testament. For example, the Ark of the Covenant in the Holy of Holies contained the tablets (Law) together with manna (Food from Heaven) and rod of Aaron. Mary as the Ark of the New Covenant carried Jesus (the Word). The Holy of Holies in our churches is the tabernacle which contains Body of Christ – Food from Heaven.

Currently twenty four people participate in the study. The sessions will continue till early May. If you would be interested to join at this point, there are audio materials available to help with catching up. Please contact the office.

Friday morning following the 9 am Mass, 12 parishioners study the Gospel of St. Luke using a DVD program lasting approx. 1/2 hr featuring Frances Hogan a scripture scholar. Luke tells us about the life of Jesus from birth through to the ascension. This account of Jesus is more detailed than any other account in the New Testament books. The writer of the Gospel of Luke has been identified as a co-worker and companion of St. Paul. The first session of this program ends Dec 12<sup>th</sup> and will resume January 9<sup>th</sup>.
