### Reflection on the Second Reading: (1Corinthians 1:26-31)

Paul grapples with those who cannot or will not see God's wisdom in a crucified Saviour. Because Corinth was a large, cosmopolitan port city of its day, members of the Church there had been exposed to many of the varied religions and philosophies that circulated among them. Paul, Jewish Apostle to the Gentiles, must attempt to present Jewish views of wisdom to those influenced by Greek philosophy. While philosophy relied on human reason and abstract propositions, Jewish wisdom saw God as the sole source of concrete, embodied wisdom.

To make his point, Paul asks community members to consider their own experience. They are all redeemed, made whole, and justified in Christ, but not because of any merit of their own. God reversed the status quo of human wisdom, which placed great value on power and rank resulting from accidents of birth. Instead, divine wisdom bestowed transformed life in Christ on "what is low and despised" to emphasize redemption as sheer gift, unearned and unmerited in every way. Christ himself embodies God's wisdom, incomprehensible to human logic or reason. By his passage through the cross to glory, Christ "became for us" divine wisdom and the source of human salvation.
