For the Ascension of the Lord Sunday:

God the Father inaugurated His presence among us when Abraham responded to Him in faith. The Nativity of Our Lord inaugurated God the Son's presence among us when God's self-expression became flesh and was born among us as one of us. This Solemnity of the Ascension of Our Lord into heaven inaugurates the time of God the Holy Spirit's presence among us. Jesus Christ ascension into heaven opens the door to the Holy Spirit's dwelling within those who have been baptized into the Body of Christ.

Our Blessed Lord's Ascension into heaven challenges us to see God in a new way. Christ's ascension is not an ending, it's a beginning. On the surface in appears that Christ's Ascension is a departure, but actually it is not. Spirit-filled in His resurrection, Christ now comes to us in a new way – in His Holy Spirit. Christ in His humanity is now taken to a new status, the highest of all states of being. Now at the right hand of the Father in the fullness of divinity, Christ comes to us in the power of the Holy Spirit --particularly in His Sacraments. He will always be with us, He will never leave us.

In today's Gospel Jesus directed the disciples to the mountain (that invokes images of Moses, Jesus's mountain top sermon and Transfiguration) and commands them:


