EXCERPT FROM THE BOOK "THE SPIRIT LIVES 1890 - 1990 A HISTORY OF ST. LOUIS PARISH WATERLOO"

The building committee then agreed to the construction of a new church and asked Mr. Moogk, an architect, for a sketch of a church from his files so as to have something to show on their rounds for subscriptions. With this in hand, Father Spetz and several members of the committee started out to gather subscriptions, starting with the Waterloo Catholics.

The church site was the subject of great difference of opinion and debate. Finally a large majority agreed on the present location on Allen Street. Looking at the site now, it is difficult to imagine what an unsightly hill it was. No wonder many people would have preferred locating somewhere else. An immense amount of labour had to be spent in grading and preparing the lot. Most of this work was done voluntarily by church members and others after working hours and on holidays.

It took a lot of work to build up the hill to its present height. Originally, it was the same elevation as the land across the street, but was built up to make the structure more prominent. To this day, the St. Louis steeple is visible for miles around.

In the spring of 1890, Mr. Letter made an early start pouring the foundation, and had the basement finished towards the end of June. His Lordship, Bishop T.J. Dowling came to lay the corner stone on the afternoon of the **third Sunday of June**. It was a beautiful day that drew a very large crowd of people.

By the beginning of 1891 construction of the church was completed far enough that it could be dedicated. On the


