The evidence for the Holy Trinity from the Gospels culminates in the baptismal commission in the Gospel of Matthew (28:19-20). It is manifest from the narratives of the Evangelists that Christ only made the great truth known to the Twelve Apostles step by step. First He taught them to recognize in Himself the Eternal Son of God. When His ministry was

drawing to a close, He promised that the Father would send another Divine Person, the Holy Spirit, in His place. Finally, after His resurrection, He revealed the doctrine in explicit terms, bidding them go and teach all nations, "baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit".
