
LENT IS A SEASON OF PENANCE, REFLECTION, AND FASTING WHICH PREPARES US FOR CHRIST'S RESURRECTION ON EASTER SUNDAY. THROUGH WHICH WE ATTAIN REDEMPTION.

FRIDAYS are days of **abstinence from meat**, but Catholics may substitute special acts of charity or piety on this day. ASH WEDNESDAY AND GOOD FRIDAY are days of

fasting and abstinence from meat.

(The law of "abstinence from meat" binds those who are 14 and older; the law of "fasting" binds those from 18 to 59 years of age. Christian fasting obtains its full meaning when we deprive ourselves of food in order to be more open to prayer, to share more in the suffering of those who are starving and to save money to give to the poor. Fasting is a penitential discipline intended to open our hearts to God and others, a means of purification and spiritual liberation, a witness of the depth of our faith - From Ordo Note 29 on Penitential Discipline.)


